How do you register?

To register with PTS you need to visit our website, www.nzcer.org.nz

1. Click on **Register**, in the top right-hand corner of the page.
2. Click on **Register to purchase psychological tests**.
3. Click on **Create new account** in the menu above **User Account**.
4. Enter your details and click on **Create new account**. An email will be sent to you with more information.
5. Click on the link provided in the email and here you can enter in your personal details and qualifications and upload any transcripts or certificates you have.
6. Once you have added all of your information to the **Test User Application Form**, click on **Register**.
7. You will then need to create a new password. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on **My Account**. Then click on **Edit** from the menu across the top of the page and here you can create your password. For security purposes, it must include a number, a non alpha-numeric character, and a capital letter (e.g., 10_Friday).

We will get back to you within two working days regarding whether we can register you or whether further information is required.
