Travel and Admin funding for SLS supernumerary teachers 2013: Factsheet

This factsheet is about the Travel and Admin funding for SLS teachers taking supernumerary surplus staffing options for 2013.

- The Ministry of Education will fund travel and admin support for previous Supplementary Learning Support (SLS) teachers who have been approved for the SLS supernumerary surplus staffing options.
- SLS supernumerary travel and admin funding will be paid to the employing school. The employing school will depend on which supernumerary option has been chosen.
- This funding applies to SLS teachers that the Ministry has approved for either the 40 week supernumerary option with the employing SLS Host School Board of Trustees, or the 30 week supernumerary option in another school.
- Admin and travel funding for SLS supernumerary teachers, who have had their applications approved by 6
 March will be paid with the April instalment of operational funding to the board employing the teacher.
 Funding for positions approved after this date will be paid at the next available opportunity.
- Fifty per cent of the annual funding will be paid in April, 25% will be paid in July, with the remaining 25% paid in October.
- Supernumerary teachers employed for 30 school weeks will have their funding pro rated so that the employing school will receive 75% of the annual allocation.
- If a teacher gets another position and is no longer supernumerary, the staffing will be removed from the school's entitlement and any funding due in future instalments will be stopped.
- SLS supernumerary teachers will be paid travel and admin funding at a similar rate to 2012. The travel rate
 depends on how much travel an itinerant teacher does. Most SLS supernumerary teachers are on travel
 rate one.
