We are well underway to transform the RTLB service alongside the school sector.

#### Latest update

- Two sector working groups were established to help redesign the RTLB service. We asked relevant professional associations to nominate members for these groups. We were impressed with the high level of interest to take part but this meant not all who were nominated are on a group. Fortunately it meant that broad sector representation across the two working groups was possible.
- The Practitioners' Working Group met on 21-22 March to review the RTLB toolkit and recommend how best to align RTLB standards with other relevant teaching standards. The group is now reviewing chapters 8-9 of the RTLB toolkit and developing a set of professional standards. You can find out more about the group and its progress <u>on-line</u>.
- The Principals' Working Group is looking at new RTLB cluster boundaries and how schools will be selected to lead the transformed RTLB service. Members will meet on 31 March to continue proposed cluster redesign discussions as well as talk about processes for consultation and implementation.
