Guidelines for allocation and use

RTL B Service Toolkit

The toolkit states that Learning Support Fund (LSF) “supports interventions developed collaboratively with RTL B, targeting students in Years 0-10. It must be used equitably and can be used innovatively.”

Allocation

The allocation of Learning Support Funding:

- is linked to need identified by the RTL B data gathering process
- occurs in the context of a conversation between RTL B and the school – with an application for LSF coming from that conversation
- is responsive – with regular referral and allocation meetings

Professional practice

RTL B will:

- share innovative ways of using the LSF within and across clusters
- choose interventions that up-skill teachers and that minimise reliance on Teacher Aides
- collaboratively set clear goals
- collect pre and post measures that demonstrate the effectiveness of the intervention
- monitor the use of Learning Support Funding.
