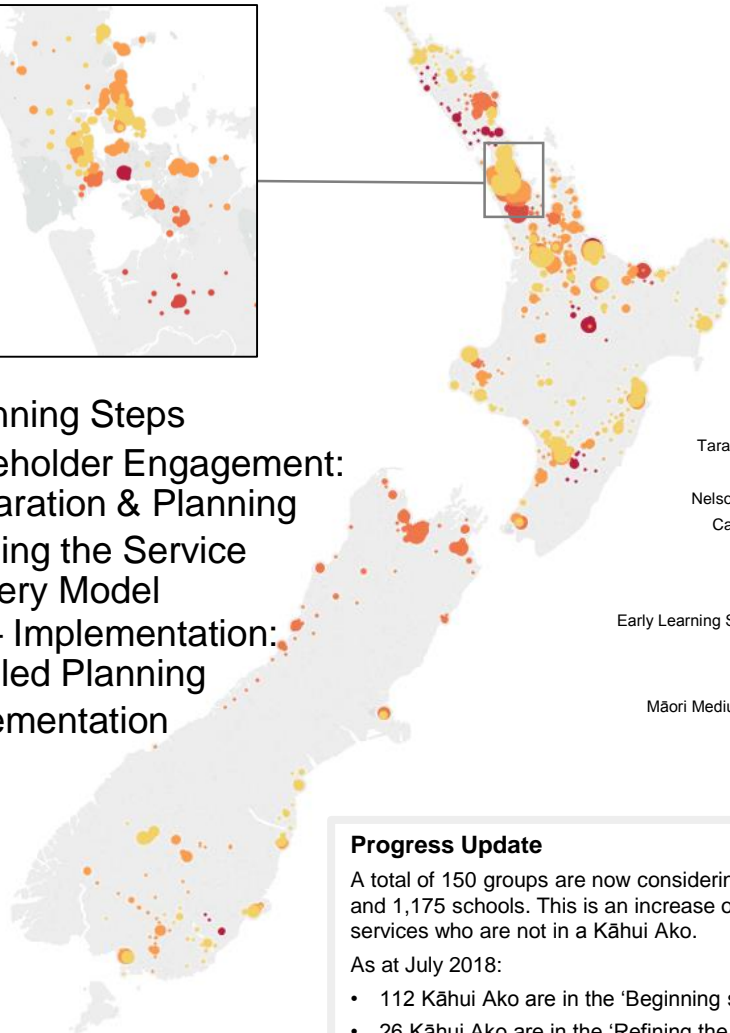
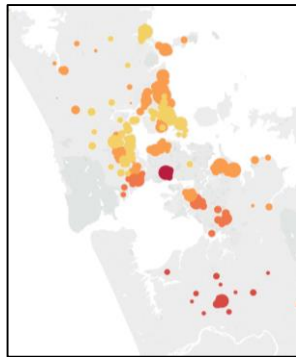


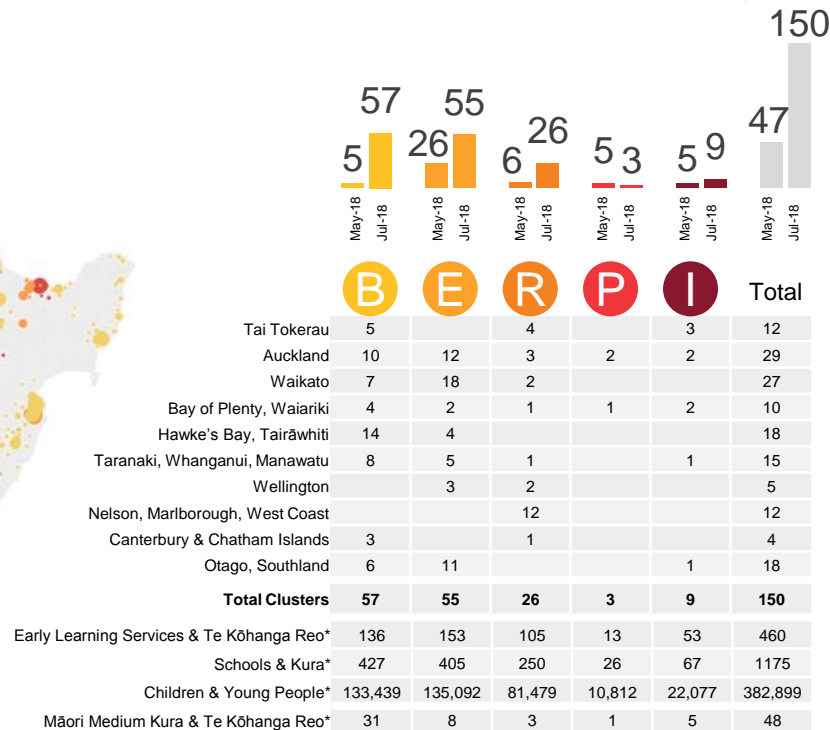

Progress Update

A total of 150 groups are now considering a Learning Support Model comprised of over 460 early learning services and 1,175 schools. This is an increase of 103 since May and includes 10 networks of schools and early learning services who are not in a Kāhui Ako.

As at July 2018:

- 112 Kāhui Ako are in the 'Beginning steps' & 'Stakeholder engagement' stages, compared to 31 in May 2018
- 26 Kāhui Ako are in the 'Refining the Service Delivery Model' stage, compared to 6 since May 2018
- 12 Kāhui Ako are in the 'Pre-implementation' & 'Implementation' stages, compared to 10 in May 2018

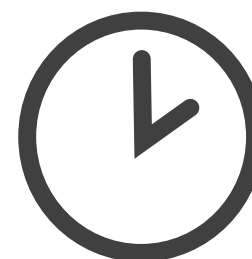
